

ORDER

Plaintiff Tiffany (NJ), LLC (“Tiffany”) filed this action against various unknown business entities who operate websites that advertise and sell counterfeit jewelry allegedly bearing Tiffany’s registered trademarks, and a number of these entities also incorporate “Tiffany” into their website domain names. Tiffany has now filed an amended complaint against a number of additional entities (#53) and an ex parte motion for a temporary restraining order against all defendants (#54). Although Plaintiff’s counsel represented that there were “[n]o changes to the parties” when filing the Amended Complaint via the court’s electronic filing system, “Schedule A,” filed with the Amended Complaint, includes a number of newly named defendants (defendants 224 through 389) and a number of additional aliases for existing defendants (compare, for example, defendant 156 on Schedule A attached to the Complaint with defendant 156 on Schedule A attached to the Amended Complaint). Plaintiff’s counsel must designate any such party changes on the electronic filing system when filing an Amended Complaint. Accordingly,

THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that Plaintiff’s Amended Complaint (#53) is STRICKEN. Plaintiff’s counsel must manage the addition of any party on the electronic case filing system, including the naming of any new defendant or new alias for any existing defendant. Plaintiff must also file an updated schedule that clearly indicates the addition of any new defendant

1 or new alias for any existing defendant. Plaintiff may refile its Amended Complaint in accordance
2 with Rule 15(a) and the language of this order. The court will consider Plaintiff's pending motion
3 (#54) upon receipt of Plaintiff's properly filed Amended Complaint.
