ORDER

THIS MATTER is before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion to Extend Temporary Restraining Order (DE 39) ("**Motion**"). On April 11, 2025, the Court granted Plaintiffs' *Ex Parte* Application for Entry of Temporary Restraining Order (DE 16) and set a hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction (DE 6) before Chief Magistrate Judge Goodman.


Judge Goodman held a hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction on April 18, 2025. (DE 34.) On the same day, Judge Goodman issued a Report and Recommendations (DE 35) ("**Report**"), recommending the Court grant Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction. (DE 35 at 11.) The Parties have fourteen (14) days to file objections to Judge Goodman's Report. (*Id.*) The Temporary Restraining Order, however, is set to expire before that period ends. Therefore, the Court finds good cause to extend the Temporary Restraining Order.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. Plaintiffs' Motion (DE 39) is **GRANTED**.

2. The Temporary Restraining Order issued by the Court on April 11, 2025 (DE 16), is **EXTENDED** and shall remain in effect until **May 6, 2025**.
