**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ALTERNATE SERVICE**

**THIS CAUSE** is before the Court upon Plaintiffs' Motion for Order Authorizing Alternate Service of Process on Defendants Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(f)(3) [DE 6] ("Motion"). The Court has carefully reviewed the Motion and supporting exhibits and is otherwise fully advised in the premises.

In the Motion, Plaintiffs ask the Court's permission to serve Defendants process by online publication and by email, including onsite contact forms and/or private messaging applications and/or services, as that is the only known contact information for Defendants. The Court finds that Plaintiffs have shown good cause for the relief they seek in the Motion, and the Motion shall therefore be granted. Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Plaintiffs' Motion for Order Authorizing Alternate Service of Process on Defendants Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(f)(3) [DE 6] is **GRANTED**. Plaintiffs shall serve the Summonses, Complaint, and all future filings and discovery in this action upon each Defendant (1) via publication by posting a copy of the same on the website appearing at the URL <http://servingnotice.com/GX1c0windex.htm> and (2) via e-mail by providing the address to Plaintiffs' designated serving notice website to Defendants via the e-mail accounts provided by each Defendant as part of the data related to each of their respective websites and social media account, including customer service e-mail addresses, as set forth on Schedule "A" [DE 6 at 17], which may include service via private messaging applications and/or services, the registrar of record for the domain names or the social media platform for the social media account, or via onsite contact forms.
