SEALED ORDER EXTENDING TRO AND CONTINUING HEARING

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on the *Ex Parte* Motion to Extend Temporary Restraining Order, Associated Deadlines, and Continue Hearing Scheduled for August 28, 2025, in Connection with Motion for Preliminary Injunction (the "Motion") filed by Plaintiff, Tiffany (NJ) LLC ("Plaintiff"). ECF No. [26]. Plaintiff requests the Sealed Temporary Restraining Order, dated August 20, 2025, ECF No. [22], be extended and the hearing scheduled for August 28, 2025, be continued to avoid prejudicing Defendants' right to appear and respond in a timely fashion.


As of the filing of the Motion, Defendants had not yet been served because Plaintiff was still awaiting full responses to the Sealed Temporary Restraining Order from the non-party financial institutions. Thereafter, Plaintiff will serve the Defendants. Accordingly, the Court finds that a continuance is necessary to allow Defendants time to appear and respond to the Motion for Preliminary Injunction.

For the foregoing reasons, it is, hereby,

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. Plaintiff's Motion ECF No. [26], is **GRANTED**.
2. The Sealed Temporary Restraining Order dated August 20, 2025, shall remain in effect until **September 4, 2025**.
3. Plaintiff shall immediately file a motion to unseal the Renewed Application, ECF No. [19], once service has been effectuated upon all Defendants.
4. The in-person hearing, originally set before this Court at the Wilkie D. Ferguson Jr. Courthouse, Courtroom 11-4, 400 North Miami Avenue, Miami, Florida 33128, on August 28, 2025 and 4:00 p.m., is continued to **September 4, 2025, at 8:30AM**, at which time Defendants and/or any other affected persons may challenge the appropriateness of this Order and move to dissolve the same and at which time the Court will hear argument on Plaintiff's requested preliminary injunction.
5. Any response or opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction in ECF No. [19] must be filed and served on Plaintiff's counsel by no later than **forty-eight hours** prior to the preliminary injunction hearing set herein.
6. Plaintiff shall file any reply memorandum on or before **twenty-four hours** prior to the preliminary injunction hearing set herein.
