SEALED ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Plaintiff, Chanel, Inc.'s Ex Parte Motion to Continue Hearing (ECF No. 14). The undersigned has carefully considered the Motion, the record in this case, and the applicable law, and is otherwise fully advised. By the instant Motion, Plaintiff requests the continuation of the hearing in connection with Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction in order to avoid prejudicing Defendants' right to appear and respond in a timely fashion. The Court finds that good cause exists to continue the hearing.

Accordingly, after due consideration, it is Ordered as follows:

1. Plaintiff's Ex Parte Motion to Continue Hearing Set for April 1, 2022 (ECF No. 14) is GRANTED.

2. The Preliminary Injunction hearing currently set for April 1, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., is hereby continued until Wednesday, April 13, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., and will be conducted via ZOOM, at which time Defendants and/or any other affected persons may challenge the appropriateness of the Sealed Temporary Restraining Order and move dissolve it and at which time the Court will hear argument on Plaintiff's requested preliminary injunction.

3. In that no notice of appearance has been filed by counsel on behalf of the Defendants, Plaintiff shall ensure that Defendants are served with a copy of this Order in accordance with the procedures set out in ECF No. 12.

4. Any evidence that the parties intend to submit to the Court must be filed into the record no later than Tuesday, April 12, 2022, at noon (12 p.m.). Witness and Exhibit Lists shall be filed with the Court with the supporting documents on Form AO 187 and must be pre-marked by Tuesday, April 12, 2022, at noon (12 p.m.).

5. By Tuesday, April 12, 2022, at noon (12 p.m.), all counsel, parties or witnesses participating shall provide their names, email addresses and phone numbers to snow@flsd.uscourts.gov. Counsel shall each provide one email with the requested information for themselves, any witnesses and any clients/parties

participating. All counsel participating must be an attorney of record certified to appear before the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida and must be members in good standing.
